

Budget and Finance Committee

Report of Chapter Finances and Recommendations

Through November 30, 2006

The Budget and Finance Committee has been charged with reviewing the Chapter financial statements, including the budgetary comparisons, and offering observations and suggestions to the Chapter Executive Committee (CEC) for consideration. We have completed our review for the period July 1, 2006 to November 30, 2006, and our observations and suggestions are outlined below. In addition, we are attaching the financial statements at and for the period ended November 30, 2006 and the Summary of Events for the period ended December 31, 2006, for CEC consideration.

Overall Financial and Budget Status

Financial Condition - The cash, balance sheet and overall financial condition appear to be in excellent shape.

Budget - The approved budget surplus was \$84. However, due to an error in the budget spreadsheet, \$1,000 in budgeted revenue and \$20 in net expenses were not included, adjusting the net budgeted surplus to \$1,064.

Profit and Loss - The Chapter Statement of Profit and Loss shows an operating at a surplus of \$12,022 at November 30, 2006. However, much, if not all, of that profit is undivided income owed to other organizations as the result of joint events and estimated expenses for the Fraud Seminar that have not been accrued. Therefore, B & F Committee feels that we are pretty close to our budget targets at this point. However, being less than half way through the fiscal year, we recommend that the CEC keep a close eye on the finances for the rest of the fiscal year and make adjustments as they become necessary.

The areas of interest for events, other revenues and expenses are highlighted below:

Events

The Chapter has held a total of 8 events (see attached Summary of Events). The actual Chapter net surplus (including some estimated expenses for the Fraud Seminar) for these events is estimated to be \$4,527 at December 31, 2006, which is \$3,394 over the budgeted surplus.

Other Revenues

We budgeted \$1,000 and have accrued \$375 in Sponsor revenue to date.

Expenses:

Through November 30 we have exceeded budget estimates for the Chapter Development (\$78) and Facilities (\$569). It looks like the primary factor for Facilities was the Fraud Seminar where the additional registrants caused an increase in facilities cost. The other line items that may need to be watched include

- Awards – We have a carry over expense of \$480 that cuts into this years Awards budget.
- Printing – It looks like we have exceeded the printing budget for Marketing by over \$300.
